#### Shoebox Gift Suggestions

##### Personal Care Items

Comb, hairbrush, toothbrush, washcloth, bar soap, adhesive bandages, nail clipper and file, stick deodorant, blanket, reusable plastic containers, flashlight (solar-powered or hand-crank; if battery operated be sure to include extra batteries).

##### Clothing and Accessories

Shirts & pants, pillowcase dress, underwear, shoes and socks, flip-flops, hats/scarf/mittens, sunglasses, tote bag/purse, hair bows, friendship bracelets.

##### School Supplies

Pencils, small manual pencil sharpener, colored pencils, pencil case, crayons, markers, pens, coloring pads, coloring books, picture book, notebooks, glue stick, playdough, stickers, solar-powered calculator, safety (blunt tip) scissors, ruler, blank index cards, protractor.

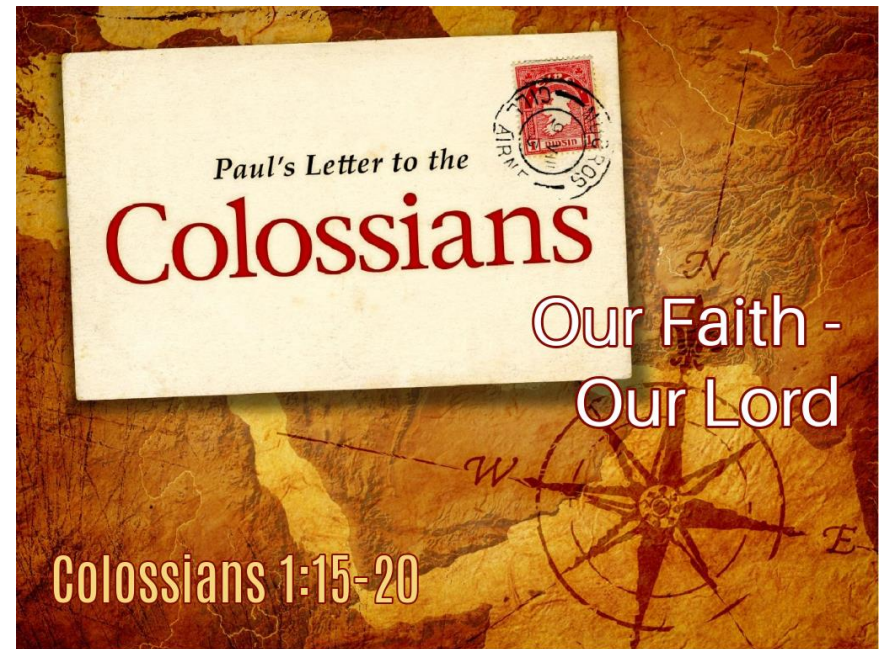
##### Crafts and Activities

Watercolor set, make-it-yourself craft items or kit, fishing kit, gardening kit with gloves and trowel (no seeds), puzzles, compass, kaleidoscope.

##### Toys

Foam ball, kickball (make sure to include a manual air pump so that the ball can be re-inflated), finger puppets, slinky, Etch A Sketch, interactive toys that include push buttons, lights, noise (include extra batteries), play cars/trucks/boats, plastic tools, plastic dinosaurs, Yo-yo, playing cards chalkboard and chalk, doll, skipping rope/jump rope, hacky sack, small frisbee.
